ENROLLING AT

Harford Community College [during the COVID-19 closures]

EMAIL YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR to make them aware that you are applying to Harford.

APPLY TO THE COLLEGE

Once on the page, click Online Application.

- a. Apply as a new student/high school graduate and declare your program of study.
- b. All students must apply, even if they have previously taken dual enrollment classes.

Within 3-5 business day students will receive an acceptance letter (via the email address provided on the application). **Do not lose this**. It will provide login information and next steps.

REQUEST YOUR HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

- a. For HCPS students: Student and parent should sign and return the transcript release form and Naviance permission form. Email signed forms to your counselor and request your transcript be sent to the College.
- b. **For non-HCPS students:** Follow your school's protocol to obtain your transcripts and have them sent to the College.



NOTE: If you have with taken the SAT, ACT, PARCC, Accuplacer, GED, AP or IB tests **OR** have a high school cumulative GPA of 3.0 (unweighted), you may be exempt from testing. **You must request that your scores be sent to Harford Community College for review.**

c. Once you confirm that transcripts and test scores (if applicable) have been sent, allow 5 business days for processing and review and then email admissions@harford.edu with your name and H-number (found in your acceptance letter). An admissions specialist will contact you to discuss whether placement testing is required as well as next steps.

COMPLETE PLACEMENT TESTING

If you need to take the Accuplacer® placement test, contact <u>testcent@harford.edu</u> to schedule a time.

Once all of the above steps are complete, an admissions specialist will verify everything and provide you with information to schedule a **My Academic Plan (MAP)*** **session**. This is where you will meet one-on-one with an academic advisor to review your classes and register for the fall semester. Currently MAP sessions are conducted on MS Teams. At this point you'll be ready for Summer Orientation!



*NOTE: Students WILL NOT be allowed to participate in this session if all of the above items have not been completed and verified by admissions.

Take advantage of Open House, Exploration Events, and Orientation.
