




Senior options

SEO Admission Requirements

- 1. Current juniors or seniors
- 2. Meet CCR standards
- 3. 90% attendance
- 4. Students may enroll in **five** courses per academic year at no cost as HCPS will pay tuition and textbook fees.

Students who earn a failing final grade, or withdraw from a course beyond the penalty free withdraw date, will be accountable for the associated tuition and fees of the respective course(s).

Additionally, students who are unsuccessful in earning credit in the dual enrollment program are ineligible for tuition payment for two consecutive college terms.

General Requirements

- Applicants must be rising juniors, juniors or seniors, age 16 years or older.

- · One year of related instruction is required.
- Applicants must be in good attendance and academic standing and on track to graduate.
- · Students must complete 450 hours of work-based training.
