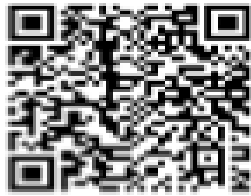

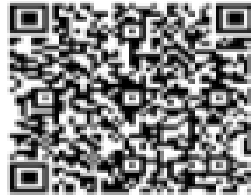

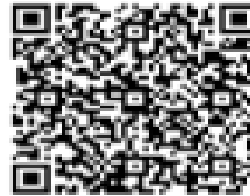

Counselor's Corner

Things to take care of this January on Naviance if you plan to attend college

What is a midyear transcript? Is that available at CMW?

Mid-year transcripts are the transcripts that include the first semester grades of your Senior Year and yes, we can help you deliver those to the schools listed in your naviance account. Mid-year transcripts are not available to be sent until **late January**. It is important to note that **not all** schools require mid-year transcripts, so determine which are necessary before you request them on Naviance, please.

Also take note that some colleges will list the mid-year transcripts as "missing" even before they can be sent. These schools know that nearly all high schools cannot send mid-year transcripts until the end of January or even early February. The "missing" indicator is just to let you know they have not arrived yet. **You are not penalized.**

Steps to request a midyear transcript:

In your Naviance account:

Colleges --> Apply to College --> Manage Transcripts

Click the *Pink Plus Sign* (in the right corner) --> *Other Transcript*

"What type of transcript are you requesting" select the box for "Mid-year"

What is this transcript for" select "Other"

Request and finish

Alfred Anderson Math Science Scholarship (\$3,000) Due February 21, 2024 to the Counseling Office

Student needs to have a unweighted GPA of 3.5 in math, science, or math/science combined

Earned a minimum of 4 credits in math (calculus preferred) and science

Keen interest in the study of math and/or science and indications that they will be majoring in it

Good school citizen, serious attitude towards academic studies

Huether-McClelland Foundation Scholarship (\$15,000) - Due February 21, 2024 to the Counseling Office

Student needs to have a unweighted GPA of 3.5 in math and science combined

Earned a minimum of 4 credits in math

Earned a minimum of 4 credits in science

Completed or currently enrolled in 1 credit physics

Completed or currently enrolled in one AP Science or Computer Science

Should be entering a college that offers a Bachelor of Science in Engineering

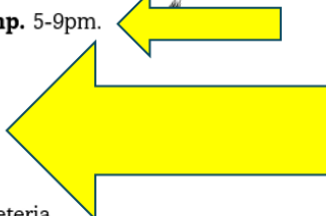
